ITEM 48.1: Welcome and Opening remarks by the Chairperson, Senate.

The Chairperson, Senate welcomed all the members to the meeting including two newly nominated Dean of IT Infrastructure & Automation, Prof. Satya S. Bulusu and Dean of Research and Development, Prof. Abhirup Dutta. The Chairperson informed the Senate members that IIT Indore successfully conducted Inter IIT Sports Meet-2024 where 2000 participants including officials were present from all 23 IITs.

The Institute also finalized to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MoE) with Military College of Telecommunication Engineering (MCTE), Mhow for commencing of new M.Tech. programs for Working defense personnel of MCTE, Mhow.

The Chairperson also shared that multiple Senate meetings will be held instead of long Senate meetings due to revision of course structure and syllabi of all B.Tech. programs under NEP-2020 and other new programs.

ITEM 48.4: Course structure of Master of Arts in English (Literature and Linguistics).

The Head of School of Humanities and Social Sciences presented the course structure of Master of Arts in English (Literature and Linguistics).

After the discussion, the Senate approved in-principal the course structure of Master of Arts in English (Literature and Linguistics) with the following remarks as given below:

- i) The Master of Arts in English (Literature and Linguistics) program will commence from the Academic Year 2025-2026.
- Valid GATE score in English (XH C2) or Linguistics (XH C3) as qualifying examination. However, JAM score in English or Linguistics may be explored in future if such examination is conducted.
- iii) GRE and TOEFL should be used initially to admit international students. However, IELTS may be included later.
- iv) Dissertation should be mentioned in the course structure instead of MA Project Stage(s) and the credit structure of this should be mentioned in L-T-P-C pattern.
- v) One of the institute elective courses should also be offered in 4th semester elective courses.
- vi) Syllabus will be discussed in subsequent meetings of the Senate.
- vii) Fellowships will be decided after getting information from other IITs in due course of time.
- viii) Initially, the total number of students intake should be 10 in each academic year.
